### **Joint Action for Climate Protection: Sulfurcell signs Berlin's Climate Alliance Declaration**

**Berlin, October 9th 2008** – On October 9th Berlin's governing mayor Klaus Wowereit and 13 well-known companies signed Berlin's Climate Alliance Declaration at the "Red Town Hall". SULFURCELL Solartechnik GmbH belongs to the first addressers.

The city of Berlin aims to reduce its CO<sub>2</sub>-emissions in the period between 1990 and 2020 by more than 40 per cent. The partners of the Climate Alliance assume in an extraordinary manner responsibility for climate protection. They help to reduce CO<sub>2</sub>-emissions and to enhance energy efficiency. "Our thin-film solar modules based on chalcopyrite-type semiconductors (CIS/CIGS) are first choice products for climate protection. But environmental protection and sustainability are not only characteristics of our products, they are also fundamental standards of our corporate decisions", says Nikolaus Meyer, Ph.D., CEO and founder of Sulfurcell, on the occasion of the signing.

This "incorporated sustainability" is exemplified by the new premises of Sulfurcell. In January 2009, expanding to mass production, the company will start building a new production hall and an administration building. Large-scale solar modules will be integrated in the production hall's roof and facades. The administration building will even be energy self-sufficient using integrated solar modules.
